Every chart stands alone so each diagnosis submitted must be supported on that record



Remember the importance of MEAT criteria



Clearly document linkage of records to the diagnosis



Complete and accurate documentation (or the lack thereof) also impacts provider reputations and income and may result in more out-of-pocket costs for their patients



Perform internal audits to assure documentation and coding support these (and all HCCs)



Provide internally or externally produced tip cards, booklets or other easily accessible tools to educate providers on commonly encountered HCC-triggering diagnoses and criteria



If not part of current process, compare provider RAF scores and query response rates as an incentive to improve capture
